Qualified candidates possess an understanding of Waldorf education and curriculum or a willingness to learn. Candidates should be creative and willing to teach outdoors in all weather conditions. Mentorship is available from an experienced movement teacher with a deep understanding of spatial dynamics and Bothmer gymnastics.
