PURPOSE/SCOPE OF THE POSITION:

The Kindergarten Afternoon Program Lead holds the <u>afternoon and after school care program</u> for kindergarten aged children. This is a contract, part-time position from September 8, 2020 to June 10, 2021. This is an afternoon only position, from 12:30 pm to 5:30 pm.

The ideal candidate will have training and/or experience in Waldorf education and working with young children. In addition, the following qualities would be required:

- Kindness, warmth, patience, energy, and a genuine dedication to Waldorf education.
- Ability to create a warm and gentle environment for young children.

- Waldorf Teacher Education certification preferred. Ability to work within Waldorf guidelines and out of anthroposophy essential.
- Two years care provider experience, or equivalent combination of education and work experience.
- Willingness and proven ability to work within a community environment.
- Recent Police Check and CPR-First Aid Training.
