



JOB POSTING: Games and Physical Education Teacher

Mulberry Waldorf School is seeking a part-time Grades School Games and Physical Education Teacher to fill a one year contract beginning July 1, 2022 until June 30, 2023.

SCOPE OF THE POSITION:

The successful candidate will lead Grades 3/4 games and Grades 5/6 and 7/8 physical education classes and work out of Mulberry Waldorf School's Vision and Mission and within our Governance Structure. This Teacher will work closely with the other Faculty, Staff, and the Pedagogical Chair to provide an exemplary Waldorf educational program. Summer professional development, as assigned by the Human Resources Committee, planning, and curriculum development is expected.

KEY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE POSITION:

The ideal candidate will have passion for holistic education as well as training and/or experience in Waldorf education. In addition, the following qualities would be required:

- Bachelor of Education Degree or equivalent experience
- Current Police Check, including the Vulnerable Sector Check
- Current Standard First Aid Certification
- Fulfil teaching and pedagogical responsibilities (curriculum, supervision, assessments) with accountability to Pedagogical Chair and Human Resources Committee
- Ability to maintain a positive, supportive, and inclusive learning environment
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills with children, colleagues and parents
- Experience and confidence with positive behaviour management
- Have excellent organizational, communication, time management, and collaboration skills
- Commit to continuing personal and professional development

COMPENSATION: Salary is determined based on qualifications, years of experience and contact hours. This will be approximately 30% of a full-time position. The current base salary for a full time Specialties Teacher is \$41,147. The school supports professional development as well as health allowances, mentoring, and tuition reduction for staff children.
