



POSTING: Pedagogical Director

Mulberry Waldorf School is seeking a Pedagogical Director for a one year, full time contract position beginning July 1, 2022 until June 30, 2023.

SCOPE OF THE POSITION: This is a lead administrative and pedagogical position working out of Mulberry Waldorf School's Vision and Mission and within our Governance Structure. The Pedagogical Director must work closely with other Faculty, Staff, and School Leadership to promote an exemplary Waldorf educational program and maintain a positive learning environment. 50% of this position will involve Student Support. Summer professional development and work with the Administrative Head is required.

KEY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE POSITION: The ideal candidate will have a passion for holistic education and the following qualifications:

- Waldorf Teacher training and/or a minimum 5 years experience in Waldorf Education
- Bachelor of Education Degree and 5 years experience in education
- Familiarity with Mulberry Waldorf School
- Knowledge of structured literacy and math to provide student support
- Proven leadership abilities
- Current Police Check, including the Vulnerable Sector Check
- Current Standard First Aid Certification

The ideal candidate will:

- Fulfill responsibilities with accountability to the Board of Directors and Human Resources Committee
- Follow the school's Code of Conduct: respecting self, others, and the environment
- Follow the Confidentiality and Conduct Agreement
- Have excellent organizational, communication, time management, and collaboration skills
